

REGION E REPRESENTATIVE: SCHOOL APPLICATION

The position of a PASC Regional Representative school holds many opportunities for the school, student council, and the individual student who is selected to hold the position. Many opportunities are provided for leadership training, travel, and development of human relations skills. With these opportunities come time commitment and leadership responsibilities.

The election, which takes place during Region Caucus at the State Conference, is for the election of a school and not an individual member of the student council. Once the school is chosen, the school will choose the student to serve as the Regional Rep. The school must be a PASC member school. The school selected must not have held a PASC regional representative seat during the past five years.

The selected student must attend the PASC Board meetings in January, March, and August, a PASC Summer Leadership Workshop, State Conferences, National Conferences and District Board meetings. The student must also publish a newsletter at least twice a year for schools in the counties of Region E. The student selected by the school must be in grades 9 or 10 in order to fulfill the two-year term. The term will begin on January 1 and end on January 31, two years later.
