DISTRICT 10 FORMED A BOARD AND APPROVED A CONSTITUTION

In an effort to **provide support** for conference host schools, to **facilitate better communication** in District 10, and to **develop quality student council programs** in our three county areas for high schools and middle schools, we designed a board structure consisting of advisors and student leaders in District 10. At the 2009 District 10 conference, we formed a District 10 Board. The Executive Board consists of 4 **high schools and two middle schools** from two of our three counties. Three committees (**Conference, Publication and Recruitment**) and three executive positions (**Director, Secretary and Treasurer**) make up the District 10 Board. Board membership will include an advisor and at least one student from each of the schools who volunteered to serve on the District 10 Board. See www.pasc.net for list.

First official District 10 Board meeting will occur during the Caucus meeting at the PASC State Conference on Nov. 12-14 @ Pennridge High School in Perkasio PA. Student Bd. Members and the District 10 Constitution will be presented. Our board will meet once or twice a year for a late afternoon or early evening meeting at a convenient site. The board will also communicate by email between meetings to facilitate other business.
