## DISTRICT 10 ADVISOR OF THE YEAR 2011

Each year, District 10 selects one high school level and one middle school level advisor as Advisor of the Year. The advisors selected at the district level are then nominated for the State Advisor of the Year Award. Student Council officers and/or School Administrators are encouraged to nominate outstanding Student Council Advisors for this special recognition.

1. Nominations must be submitted in writing to Penny Diehl, Easton Area High School, 2601 William Penn Highway, PA. 18045.or prior to announced Spring 2011 District 10 Board meeting.
2. Nominations should originate from students.
3. Letters of recommendation from the Student Council President and the Principal should accompany the nomination form.
4. Letters of recommendation should demonstrate the nominee's commitment to students, student organizations, and the school program.
5. Advisors must have at least **three (3) years** of student government experience.
6. The District 10 Advisor of the Year is ineligible for nomination in the calendar year following his/her recognition.
7. Selection of the 2011 Advisor of the Year will take place at the spring District Board meeting (to be announced). Each board member school present will have one vote in the process.
8. The announcement and recognition of the Advisor of the Year will occur at the annual spring conference.
