STATE CONFERENCE CHARTER TRAVEL

Look for info on charter travel to the state conference via e-mail. Approximate cost is \$75. Contact Rose Ann if you do not currently receive District Director Reminder e-mails.

Transportation Options during the Conference. There will be short travel times (15-20 minutes) from most hotels and the University, to Old Forge JSHS on Friday afternoon, and to the Banquet on Friday night. Options will be identified as part of regular online registration in late August/September. They include:

- A. Advisors drive students in their school vans or cars.
- B. Western Pennsylvania delegates coming on charter buses will use those same buses for transportation during the conference if they are staying at the Ramada or Nicholls Inn. (If Western PA delegates choose to stay at one of the other hotels, they must also choose option C, pay the \$10 transportation fee and use the local school buses.)
- C. A limited number of local school buses will be available. There will be a \$10 transportation fee per delegate to cover this cost and must be pre-paid when registering. (If, *and only if*, we have any available seats on the charter buses, schools who drove to Scranton and are staying at the Ramada or Nicholls Inn may opt to pay the \$10 transportation fee to District 2 for shuttle services in Scranton.)
