

NASC ADVISORY COUNCIL STUDENT MEMBER APPLICATION

The NASC Advisory Council membership consists of four students and four advisors, one from each of the eight NASC regions of the country. For the past two years, NASC Region 2 has been represented by an adult member, Mr. Lou Miller of New Jersey. Region 2 includes the states of: Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, New York, and Pennsylvania. In the spring of 2012, the State Student Council organizations of Region 2 will be responsible for the selection of one student from the Middle Atlantic States to serve on the NASC Advisory Council. Each of these states may nominate one current 9th or 10th grade student as their nominee. Interviews will be held in April to select one of these state nominees for the NASC Advisory Council Region 2 Representative for 2012-2014. This student will:

1. Serve from July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2014.
2. Foster communication between the State Presidents and Executive Directors of the Middle Atlantic states.
3. Communicate student ideas and concerns from the states of Region 2 to NASC and the other members of the NASC Advisory Council.
4. Assist with the planning of the annual spring meeting of NASC Region 2 State Officers and Executive Directors.
5. Foster the sharing of ideas and projects among the state organizations of Region 2 as well among student leaders across the nation.
6. The student will be required to attend an NASC Advisory Council meeting in Reston, Virginia in January 2013 and 2014, the NASC Conference in June 2012, June 2013, and June 2014. The student may also be required to attend an NASC LEAD Conference in 2013 and 2014. In this role the student Advisory Council members will be asked to do the following:
 - a. Identify and bring forth student council-related issues, topics and concerns to NASC.
 - b. Provide critical review, feedback, and recommendations on issues, topics or concerns as requested by the NASSP Board and staff.
 - c. Provide periodic review and recommend revisions or enhancements to NASC Awards programs as requested.
 - d. Assist NASC staff as called upon during the NASC National Conference
 - e. Members may be asked to attend other meetings or conferences in which student input is needed. NASC covers expenses for all required meetings.
7. If the Pennsylvania nominee is selected for this position, they will also be invited to attend three PASC Executive Board meetings and the PASC State Conference per year and to make reports to PASC during his/her term of office. Transportation, meals, and accommodations for meeting will be paid for by PASC.

PASC now seeks to begin the process of naming a Pennsylvania nominee for this position. Present freshman and sophomores may apply. Since the spring of 2010, Region 2 has had a Student Liaison, Pennsylvania's own, Sarah Rudasill of New Oxford HS, who has fulfilled the responsibilities listed above with the exception of items #6. The following is the PASC application process.

1. The application is due to the PASC Office by postmark deadline February 1, 2012.
2. The PASC committee on NASC Relations will review student applications and select up to five finalists. Students will be notified by February 15, 2012.
3. The finalists will be interviewed by the NASC Relations Committee on Friday, March 2, 2012 prior to the PASC Executive Board meeting in New Castle, PA.
4. The PASC nominee along with other nominees from NASC Region 2 states will be interviewed at the NASC Region 2 State Officers meeting in Maryland on Saturday, April 21, 2012.

3. Must be able to attend PASC Executive Board Meeting for interview in New Castle, PA on March 2, 2012
4. Must be able to attend NASC Region 2 Selection interviews on April 20-22 in Annapolis, MD. (transportation provided by PASC)
