State Conference

Enlighten Student Councils...SHOCK Your Schools is the theme for this year's state conference which will be mainly held on the campus of Scranton University. The conference will be held October 7th-9th 2010. Early-Bird Registration is **April 15th-July 30th**. Regular registration will be **August 25th-September 22nd**. A point about the conference I would like to stress is transportation. During the conference there will be short travel times from the hotels to the University, Old Forge JSHS, and to the Banquet. One option PASC has is that advisors drive students in school vans or personal cars. Another option SCRANTON will have is a limited number of local school buses available for use, but there will be a \$10 transportation fee to cover this cost per delegate and must be pre-paid when registering. Also, if you are interested in presenting a workshop for the conference make sure you have it all together now, so you are ready to mail in your idea/request when registration time comes around.

Summer Workshops

Blue- Workshop category for middle level students entering grades 7, 8, or 9

Gold- Workshop category for high school students entering grades 9, 10, 11, or 12

Advanced Gold- Workshop category for high school students entering grades 11, or 12 who have previously attended a gold workshop

Registration deadlines for ALL workshops are as follows:

Early-Bird Registration- Must be postmarked by **May 14th**

Regular Registration- Must be postmarked by **June 11th**

Blue- Grove City College, **July 18th-22nd**

Lebanon Valley College, **July 25th-29th**

Gold- Grove City College, **July 11th-16th**

Susquehanna University, **July 25th-30th**

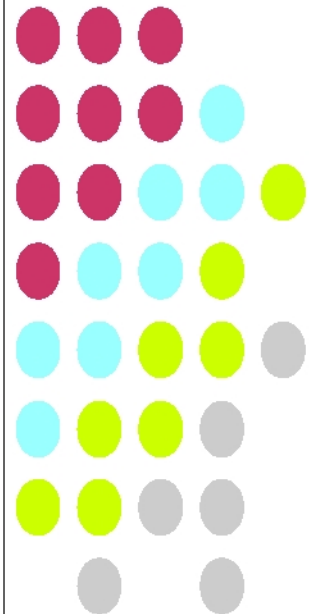
Advanced Gold- University Of Pittsburgh/Johnstown, **July 18th-24th**
