## ***Regional Representative***

### ***Purpose:***

*The purpose of this document is to standardize the procedure of the selection of Regional Representatives. The representative shall serve of the PASC Executive Board and represent the schools within his/her region. This document is to assist a school in filling a Regional Representative's position by providing the following guidelines.*

### ***Guidelines:***

- 1. The applicant must be from a PASC member school. The school selected to hold a seat on the PASC Executive Board must not have held a PASC regional representative seat during the past five years. If a student is selected from a PASC member junior high school both the junior high school and high school which the student will attend must be PASC members.*
- 2. The applicant must be in grades 9-11 in a Pennsylvania secondary school during the year they will serve. The term will begin on **January 1** and end on **January 31** of the following year.*
- 3. The selection process must be based on an application process.*
- 4. Because of the nature of this position, interested students must have student council or student government experience.*
- 5. The application must include, in part, essay questions. A sample application is enclosed.*
- 6. The selection must be carried out by a panel.*
  - A. This panel must be composed of representatives from the faculty, administration, student body, and community.*
  - B. The selection should be made by the panel but the school's administration should have veto power. Once this entire process is complete, the decision shall be final.*
  - C. This panel should reconvene in any case where the selection of a new Regional Representative is deemed necessary whenever a vacancy occurs.*
- 7. The school chosen to select a Regional Representative must have the selection process completed by December 4.*
- 8. The regional representative's advisor is responsible for notifying the Executive Director of the selection by December 15 and providing the name, home address, home telephone number, as well as the appropriate school address and telephone number at which the representative may be contacted.*
- 9. A copy of the Regional Representatives Responsibilities List must be returned to the District Director signed by the advisor, and principal prior to the start of the caucus meeting at the state conference.*

*10. A copy of the Regional Representatives Responsibilities List must be returned to the PASC Executive Director signed by the student and student's parents or guardian as soon as possible after December 4.*

*11. Each Regional Representative's position will be reviewed at the August State Board meeting. Any Regional Representative may be removed from by the State Executive Board for just cause.*
